RE: ALL COURT PROCEEDINGS

To Whom It May Concern:

In accordance with updated Federal and State guidelines, the 220th District Court will extend the suspension of in-person court hearings to **June 1, 2020**.

All essential proceedings will be conducted remotely unless a remote hearing is not possible or feasible. Essential proceedings include, but are not limited to: criminal magistration proceedings, CPS removal hearings, temporary restraining orders/injunctions, juvenile detention hearing, family violence protective orders, certain mental health proceedings, and/or certain motions to proceed/revoke. If an essential proceeding must be held in person, the following rules apply:

- 1. No more than 10 persons will be in the courtroom or in areas around the courtroom;
- 2. All participants must wear face coverings;
- 3. All participants must be separated consistent with social distancing and other precautions; and
- 4. All evidence is to be submitted in accordance with the Court's rules for remote hearings.

No in-person hearings for non-essential matters will be approved.
