Hamilton County Commissioners Court met in regular session on Wednesday, December 27, 2017 at 9:00 A.M. with the following members present: County Judge Mark Tynes, Commissioners Johnny Wagner, Keith Allen Curry, Lloyd Huggins and Dickie Clary.

Tynes called the meeting to order and a quorum was established.

Clary led the invocation and Tynes followed with the pledges.

There were no public comments.

There were no line item transfers submitted.

A motion was made by Wagner and seconded by Curry to approve the following consent agenda:

A motion was made by Wagner and seconded by Huggins to approve Hamilton County Precinct 1 to use their equipment for clean up after the Hamilton County Youth Fair. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Huggins and seconded by Curry to approve the contract renewal with Ricoh on the copier/printer for Treasurer, Tax Assessor/Collector, Justice of the Peace Precinct 1 and the District Clerks Office.
