Hamilton County Commissioner's Court met in regular session on Tuesday, February 12, 2019 at 9:00 A.M. with the following members present: County Judge Mark Tynes, Commissioners Johnny Wagner, Keith Allen Curry and Lloyd Huggins. Commissioner Dickie Clary was absent.

Tynes called the meeting to order and a quorum was established.

Tynes led the invocation and followed with the pledges.

There were no public comments.

There were no line item transfers.

A motion was made by Huggins and seconded by Curry to approve the following consent agenda:
